Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) – June 19, 2018

Transportation Concurrency and LOS Comp Plan and Code Amendments

Description of proposal: The City of Sammamish is proposing non-project action amendments to the Glossary and Transportation Element of the Sammamish Comprehensive Plan and related Municipal Code amendments to the City of Sammamish’s transportation concurrency and level of service (LOS) regulations (Titles 14, 14A, 20, 21A, 21B, and 27A SMC). The proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan include amendments to policies as well as technical background information and definitions. The proposed Municipal Code amendments include regulations for concurrency and LOS, as well as non-substantive and reference updates to other parts of the SMC for consistency.

The City Council will hold two public hearings regarding the proposed amendments on July 10, 2018 and July 17, 2018.

Proponent: City of Sammamish, Department of Public Works

Location of proposal: The Comprehensive Plan and Municipal Code apply within the corporate boundaries of the City

Lead agency: City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development

The Lead Agency for this proposal has determined the proposal, as presented in the Environmental Checklist, will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Threshold Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) is appropriate. This decision was made after review of a completed Environmental Checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date below. An EIS is not required. Comments on the project proposal and DNS must be submitted in writing and received by the deadline described below. Pursuant to SMC 20.15.130 (1)(d) there is no administrative appeal process for this action.
