Proposed changes to the Sammamish Comprehensive Plan

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sammamish City Council will hold a public hearing regarding proposed changes to the Sammamish Comprehensive Plan's Capital Facilities Element to update, by reference, the recently adopted school impact fees and Capital Facilities Plans of the Issaquah, Lake Washington, and Snoqualmie Valley School Districts.

SUMMARY of AMENDMENTS: The City Council is considering amendments to the Comprehensive Plan's Capital Facilities Element to update, by reference, new school impact fees and Capital Facilities Plans for the three school districts within Sammamish.

HEARING SCHEDULE: Public testimony will be taken by the City Council on November 6, 2018 at a public hearing. The public hearing will be part of a regular public meeting which will start at 6:30 PM at the City of Sammamish City Hall, located at 801 228th Avenue SE, Sammamish. The ordinance containing the proposed changes is scheduled to be adopted at the same meeting.
