

## CITY OF SAMMAMISH PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Sammamish will hold a public hearing on **March 2, 2021** for the purpose of accepting public comment regarding the adoption of an ordinance of the City of Sammamish, Washington, declaring public use and necessity for property rights to be condemned as required for the **George Davis Creek Fish Passage Project**.

Project involves removing fish passage barriers and replacing storm drainage infrastructure from approximately 800 feet of George Davis Creek beginning at the stream outfall at Lake Sammamish. Condemnation impacts certain property rights associated with stream flows through Tax Parcel 077710-0045, where George Davis Creek currently meets Lake Sammamish.

The Ordinance will authorize payment therefor from the City's stormwater enterprise fund. The public hearing will be held as part of a regular City Council meeting scheduled to begin at 6:30 pm.

Pursuant to the Governor's emergency Proclamation 20-25, the City is unable to provide an in-person location for the public to listen to the virtual City Council meeting this evening. Meetings are still accessible to the public and public comment can be submitted.
