Subject: Width of the E. Lake Sam Trail

Hello, I'm just sending a brief comment about the proposal for the width of the final segment of the E. Lake Sam Trail. I live in Redmond, and everyone consistently wishes that our portion of the Sammamish River Trail were wider. I even hear my Redmond neighbors complaining that Redmond is spending money on converting old rail beds to trails rather than widening the Sam River Trail, even though the two issues are not related, and KC controls the Sam River Trail—not Redmond. But to put my point in context, your city has the option to build a trail at the right width—one that is consistent with the rest of the finished portions of the E. Lake Sam Trail. Don't make a mistake that everyone will be clamoring for you to undo when use of the trail reaches capacity like the River Trail. Make it the wider width and give yourself a lot more future flexibility and satisfied trail users.
