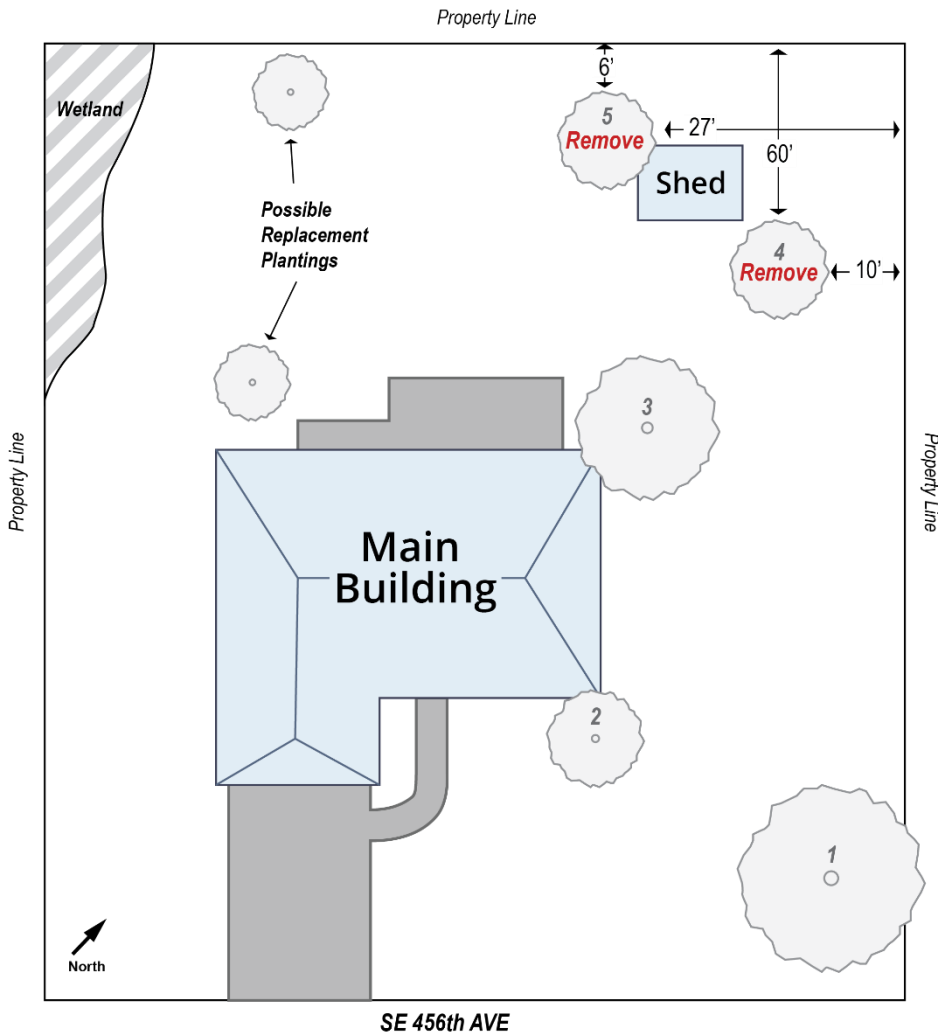


EXAMPLE SITE PLAN – HEALTHY TREE REMOVAL

Your site plan should include:

- North arrow, property lines, and structures drawn to scale (as best you can).
- Applicant name, street address, and King County parcel identification number.
- The distance from at least two property lines for trees to be removed.
- Approximate location of all **significant trees**, clearly labeling those to be removed.
- Location of any sensitive areas (wetlands, streams, steep slopes) and **replacement trees**. If any non-significant trees are being removed within sensitive areas, please mark them.
- A Tree Description Table that lists all significant trees and notes which are to be removed.
