Proposed amendments to the Sammamish Addendum to the King County Surface
Water Design Manual

Public Hearing Date: July 2, 2024

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sammamish City Council will hold a public hearing on proposed amendments to the Sammamish Addendum to the King County Surface Water Design Manual (KCSWDM).

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS: The proposed amendments to the Sammamish Addendum to the King County Surface Water Design Manual include reducing restrictions on bioretention underdrains, clarifying dispersion device setbacks for steep slopes, requiring rain barrels to be labeled as permanent stormwater facilities, prohibiting shared low impact development (LID) facilities with shared maintenance responsibility, clarifying infiltration rate testing procedures, and minor language edits.

HEARINGS SCHEDULE: Public testimony will be taken by the City Council on July 2, 2024 regarding the proposed amendments to the Sammamish Addendum to the King County Surface Water Design Manual. The public hearing will be part of a regular public meeting, which will start at 6:30 PM. The live meeting will be held at City Hall Council Chambers – 801 228th Avenue SE.
