Lot lines determine how far away structures must be from different boundaries.

FRONT YARD LOT LINES SMC 21.04.040(B)(209)


The front yard lot line is the property boundary or property line along a public street. If the property is not directly on a public street, but is accessed by an easement or private street, then the front yard lot line is where the lot gains primary access.

REAR YARD LOT LINES SMC 21.04.040(B)(210)

The rear yard lot line is the property boundary or property line opposite the front yard lot line. If the property has more than one front yard, or is a triangular shaped lot, then it does not have a rear yard lot line.

SIDE YARD LOT LINES SMC 21.04.040(B)(211)

The side yard lot line is the property boundary or property line along the side portion of the property, generally between the front and rear yard lot lines.
