## **Budget Philosophy**

- Generally maintain LOS and hold staff harmless following Council direction
- Follow Fiscal Sustainability Taskforce recommendations
- Reflect Council's Fiscal Sustainability goal
- Improve trust and transparency in the budget and capital planning process
- Acknowledge structural imbalance requires new revenues
  - > Implement 6% Utility Tax by January 2026
  - > Direction to staff to explore creation of Metropolitan Park District



## 2025-2026 Budget Highlights

### Cost-saving measures applied to all departments

- "What ifs" and contingencies gone
- Office supplies reduced
- Out of state travel restricted & training reduced
- Reduced number of seasonal positions
- Greatly reduced meeting meals
- Limited overtime
- Continuing to reduce costs (e.g., cell phones)



## Budget Amendment #1 | Staff Recommended

#### **Amendment #1 - General Fund Changes:**

- Move project costs from 2024 to 2025, zero net effect on fund balance:
  - o Repair costs
  - Impact fee study
  - EMPG grant
- Adjusted final fire budget
- Adjusted final police budget
- Reduced budget for change in level of service for snow & ice removal
- Increased vacancy allowance, resulting in budget reduction

## Budget Amendment #1 | Other Funds (no effect on general fund)

#### **Amendment #1 - Other Fund Changes:**

- Fund 301: Added \$200 thousand to fire station 83 for owner representative
- Fund 302: Removed contingency budget, removed budget for signage, moved greenhouse project budget to the 2027-2028 biennium
- Fund 340: Added budget for ELSP analysis and 30% design
- Funds 408 & 438: Adjusted budget for Hazel Wolf culvert improvement and ELSP analysis & 30% design
- Fund 501: Reduced budget for snow & ice LOS, moved purchase of one vehicle from 2024 into 2025
- No effect on General Fund at this time

## Budget Amendments #5 and #7 | Council Recommended

#### Council amendments approved on November 4, 2024:

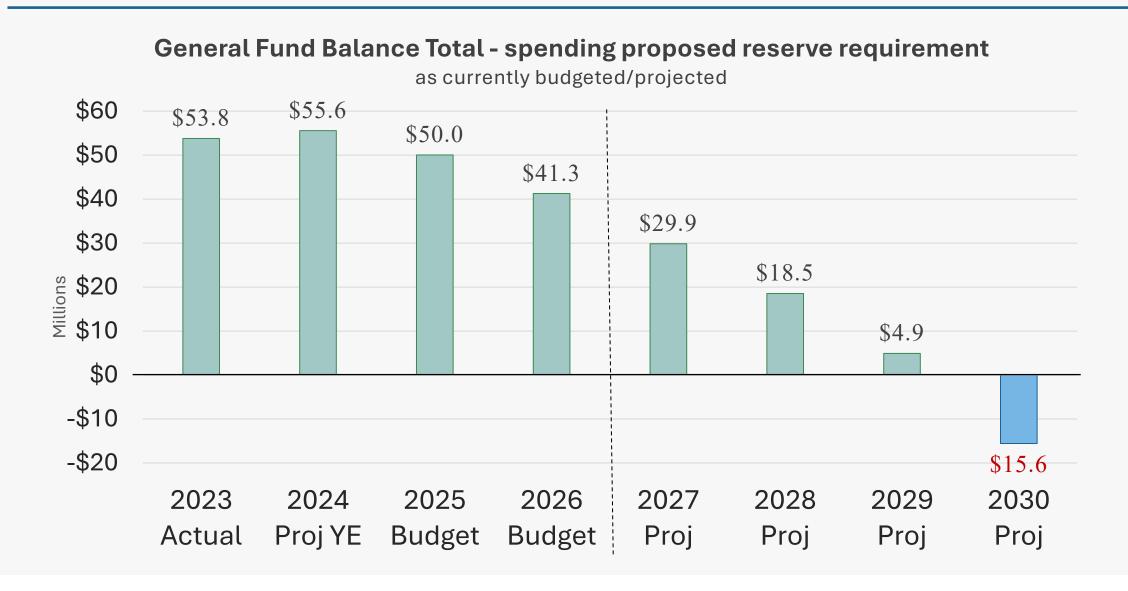
- Swap the primary funding source for the Town Square project from the general fund to the Parks CIP land acquisition dollars
- Add \$300 thousand aimed at enhancing the City's sustainability initiatives, funded by savings from the amendment above

## General Fund After Amendments Applied

#### **Net effect of amendments on General Fund:**

- Use of \$14.3 million in existing fund balance
- After adjustments, ongoing expenditures exceed ongoing revenues by \$6.7
  million for the biennium
- Departmental expenditure budget increases of just 0.4% compared to the 2023-2024 biennial budget, excluding transfers for capital projects

## Budget Amendment #7 | Scope

#### Adds \$300,000 total in 2025-2026 for sustainability

- Scope: Land use, building, and public works code and policy updates.
- **Objective:** Identify incentives and requirements to integrate sustainable practices into building and site design
- Methods: Gap analysis and inventory, community outreach, industry outreach, market feasibility, and economic viability analysis
- Process: Sustainability Commission, Planning Commission, City Council review
- Outcome: Some near term implementation with emphasis on far term recommendation of code and policy updates. Will inform future work plan items

## Budget Amendment #7 | Work Plan Impact

#### **Environment**

- E4 | PSE Green Power: Delay citywide promotion component one year
- E5 | Waste Reduction Programs: Delay program expansion at least one year
- E9 | Urban Forest Management Plan Right Sizing: Delay to 2027-2028
- E13 | Tree Regulations Update: Delay six months

#### Housing

- H2 | Neighborhood Centers Plan: Delay 1.5 years
- H4 | Centers and Corridors Plan: Delay one year

#### **Trust & Transparency**

• T2 | Title 24A Update: Delay to 2027-2028
