ABOUT THE ADULT FAMILY HOME INSPECTION CHECKLIST

To apply for an Adult Family Home (AFH) inspection, you will need to obtain an inspection from the City .

Changes to an existing structure may require additional permits:

- Remodel work, such as structural, plumbing, electrical, fire systems, clearing and grading
- Removal, decommissioning, and/or changes to septic systems, wells, and fuel tanks

Please note that demolitions, pools, retaining walls, and detached structures require the submittal of a separate demolition or building permit.

A separate PDF of each document is required at the time of submittal.

Please include all the necessary documents to have a complete submittal package to get you through the review process as quickly as possible.
