ABOUT THE TENT SUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

A fire permit is needed for a tent because tents, especially large ones, can pose a significant fire hazard due to their flammable fabric, potential for open flames or heat sources inside, and limited escape routes, so a permit ensures that proper safety measures are in place to protect people in case of a fire, including factors like location, occupant capacity, emergency exits, and flame retardant treatment of the tent material.
